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
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VIEWPOINT 02: Dunnet Head



Park at the car park at the Dunnet Head lighthouse and head inland along the footpath that follows the boundary wall towards the terraced houses. Take the second footpath to the right and continue to the Ordnance Survey mapped viewpoint with information boards on the small summit.



VIEWPOINT 03: Duncansby Head



Park at the car park by Duncansby Head lighthouse. Do not go through the gate to the lighthouse but head south (inland)across the grass to the trig point to the west of the fence enclosure. The viewpoint is located approximately 10m to the south of the trig point.

VIEWPOINT 04: Keiss



Park in Keiss and walk south along the A99 out of the settlement envelope. The viewpoint is located on the verge at the junction with the first small road to the right.



Take Stewart Cresent south-eastwards from Thrumster, and where the road forks take the lefthand road. Park in the small layby at the end of the road. The viewpoint is located at the information board at the end of the road.



VIEWPOINT 07: Yarrows Archaeological Trail



Park at the Yarrows Archaeological Trail car park and take the path heading up hill to the south-west. The viewpoint is located on the footpath at the farthest south point on the path at a high point, just after the path turns east beyond the standing stone and south of the chambered cairn.



From the A99 take the minor road south-east at the phone booth, which is almost opposite the route signed towards the Cairn of Get. Park at the small car park at the end of the road. Take the footpath down towards Whaligoe Steps and follow it around the house. The viewpoint is located on the path after the first flight of steps.





VIEWPOINT 11: Morven



Park at the small parking area near the phone box at the end of the public road to Braemore. Take the road over the bridge to the left and follow the road (do not take the road to the left just after the bridge) then follow the road round to the left. Take the second left (marked with a sign for walkers) which turns right after a short distance where it follows a boundary. Continue all the way along the path (ignoring the path to the right to an outbuilding) through a gate in a wildlife fence until it meets a track. Turn left along the track and continue along it for approximately 3.3km where there is a turning circle and a track off to the right to the cottage at Corrichoich. After this the terrain becomes boggy. Follow the all terrain vehicles track that runs to the right of the small block of coniferous forestry. After it peters out aim for the eastern end of Morven and the slight saddle between it and Carn Mor. A path then skirts the southern edges of Morven which then heads up its slopes between patches of scree. Follow this to the top past a tor on the right and then head left towards the summit where the viewpoint is located.
